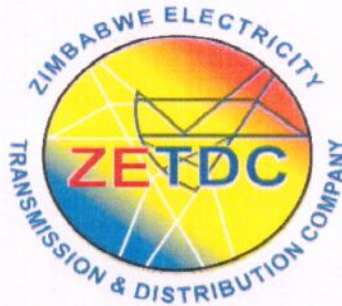

ADDENDUM NO. 2 TO STANDARD BIDDING DOCUMENT: TENDER ZETDC/INTER/12/2022

Section 8, Sub-Section 2(a) of the Public Procurement and Disposal of Public Assets (General) Regulations, 2018, clearly states that, (2) "The percentage domestic preference allowable shall be (a) up to **fifteen per centum** for the procurement of goods".
